


Scheduling Flexibility	Children on half days may extend to full days at a rate of S\$30 per day extended - payable termly in advance. Any combination of afternoon days may be chosen from 1 to 5 days per week. In the Busy Bees class children must do full days.

Other important fee information

Fee revisions	Fees are revised annually at the start of each calendar year or when there are programme changes resulting in fee changes. At least 1 months' notice will be given for changes in fees.
Tax (GST)	Currently the school does not have to pay GST as annual revenues are below the registration threshold. However, this could well change during the third term of 2015-16 and then GST at 7% will be payable from that point onwards. We will provide advance notice of this change.
Start dates	When places are available it is possible for children to start mid way in a term. Fees are then pro-rated according to the start date.
Teaching approach	At Rain Trees we aim to provide a creative environment, which is both stimulating and challenging. Children learn best through doing and we give ample opportunities to explore, experiment and discover with hands-on equipment and materials in an adult directed setting. Our curriculum is based on the UK Early Years National Curriculum. For further information download the Parents Handbook from the website. Rain Trees Kindergarten is one of only a few Foreign System Schools approved in Singapore and is regulated directly by the Ministry of Education.
Parent & Toddler Play Group	The Parent & Toddler Group is open to children aged up to 2.5 years. The group is open to registered and non registered parents (registered parents have priority).
Registration fee	S\$750 (non refundable)
Acceptance deposit	S\$1,000. Deposits are fully refundable provided three months' written notice of withdrawal is given (referenced to the end date of their final term at RainTrees). The deadline dates for withdrawal are communicated via the newsletter. The refundable deposit is not deductible from the fees and it is not transferable to other children. Refunds will be made within 14 days of your child's last day at the kindergarten.
Refund of fees	Term fees once paid are not refundable, in full or in part, in any circumstances.
Payment of fees	By cheque or bank transfer. We invoice for fees 6 weeks before the end of the current term for the following term, and give 30 days for payment. Children with fees outstanding are unable to attend Rain Trees unless by prior agreement for exceptional cases.
